Elijah Craig Small Batch (12)

The aromas have a light touch, offering honey and caramel and cocoa in a straightforward, confident balance. The flavours follow with a full, spicy finish. 1oz-6.25 2oz-11

Maker's Mark

Med. to full bodied bourbon. Wheat in the mash forms this smooth drink. 1oz-6 2oz-10.50

Bulleit Bourbon

Dark Copper colored, with an oaky nose. A touch of heat, spicy with flavors of Orange peel. Too smooth to be 90 proof. 1oz-6.25 2oz-11

Bulleit Rye

Aged in white oak barrels that are charred to the maximum before being filled. Made with 95% rye and is a copper color with slight green patina. 1oz-6.25 2oz-11

Blanton's

The taste profile is sweet, with notes of citrus and oak. The creamy vanilla nose is teased with caramel and butterscotch, all underscored by familiar baking spices such as clove, nutmeg, or cinnamon. 1oz-10.75 2oz-20.50

Woodford Reserve

Sweet buttery molasses flavor with a light finish. 1oz-7.50 2oz-14.50

Angel's Envy

Gold color laced with reddish amber hues, nearly copper in tone, with an aroma of subtle vanilla, raisins, maple syrup and toasted nuts. On the palate, you'll detect vanilla, ripe fruit, maple syrup, toast and bitter chocolate. Finishes clean with a lingering sweetness and a hint of Madeira that slowly fades. 1oz-7.50 2oz-14.50

Angel's Envy Rye

Angel's Envy Rye spends up to 18 months finishing in Caribbean rum casks, resulting in an immensely complex whiskey. The mingling of raw, spicy and earthy rye with the mellow sweetness of rum finishing creates an incomparably smooth and drinkable whiskey. 1oz-17 2oz-31

Basil Hayden's

Blessed with rich hints of peppermint, notes of pepper, slight citrus overtones, and a spicy, warming finish. 1oz-7.50 2oz-14.50

Russell's Reserve Rye

A rich, tawny color with notes of almond and allspice. Its lively taste works in a smooth, complex palate. 1oz-8.25 2oz-16.00

Eagle Rare

Bold, dry, oaky flavors with notes of candied almonds and very rich cocoa. Dry and lingering finish. 1oz-6.50 2oz-12

Larceny

Made from a mash of corn, wheat, malted barley and rye, Larceny Bourbon carries on the tradition of Old Fitz by using wheat as the bourbon's secondary grain rather than rye. After the grains are milled, they are cooked in Kentucky limestone water and fermented using a proprietary strain of yeast. 1oz-6 2oz-10.50

Templeton Rye Whiskey

Balanced in its sweet and spicy side, with a woody current throughout and a minty tinge to it that compliments the spicy rye side nicely. 1oz-7 2oz-13

Buffalo Trace

Made from the finest corn, rye and barley malt, this whiskey ages in new oak barrels for years in century old warehouses until the peak of maturity. The taste is rich and complex, with hints of vanilla, toffee and candied fruit. The smooth finish lingers on the palate. 1oz-6 2oz-10.50

Knob Creek

Nine years of aging in deeply charred barrels gives a rich full flavor and deep amber coloring. 1oz-6.25 2oz-11

Ridgemont 1792

An extremely bold bourbon...rich and velvety. Smooth with a high proof. 1oz-6.25 2oz-11

Ardbeg (10)

Smoky nose with a full, robust palate of peat smoke flavoured with turf and lapsang souchong tea. Finishes salty, long and filled with fragrant peat reek. A punch in the chops from a stroppy Islay middleweight. Flavour-packed yet delicate. 1oz-9 2oz-17.50

Bowmore

12 Year Fragrant smokiness against an oily, earthy, background. Some seaweed. Some sherry. Smokiness is sustained all the way through and surges in the finish with lots of salt. 1oz-10 2oz-19

Lagavulin Distillers Edition

Has an aroma of intense raisins, prunes and smoke. The initial notes are surprisingly sweet, with subtle hints of caramel, vanilla and dates that are balanced by a smoky undertone. The everlasting finish has deep, dark notes of red fruits and a round, bold finish. 1oz-18 2oz-32

Gordon And Macphail Caol Ila (10)

Sweet and fruity, with influences of stewed plums, heather honey and a lingering cured meat aroma. Black cracked pepper initially with vanilla, orange zest and cinnamon flavours. A underlying smokiness lingers. 1oz-13 2oz-25

Isle of Jura (10)

Deep amber gold in color, with a light, rich and aromatic nose and silky, almond wood notes. Palate is firm and distinguished, with elegant tones. A fruity oiliness with just a hint of smoke gently enriches the palate. 1oz-7.50 2oz-14.50

Kilchoman Sanaig

Sanaig, named after an inlet on Islay's rugged Atlantic coast, is a vatting of Kilchoman matured in both sherry and bourbon barrels. This sherry cask scotch whisky is matured in a high proportion of oloroso barrels, imparting a balance of dried fruits, dark chocolate and rich peat smoke into the spirit. 1oz-12.25 2oz-23.50

Laphroaig

10 Year Nose is thick peat with a soft, oaky background. Continuous gentle waves of dry peat lap upon the tastebuds but are balanced by a sweet malt middle and vanilla. Finishes long and peaty, the shy vanilla now begins to show as the oak adds a certain dryness. 1oz-8.75 2oz-17

Quarter Cask A vibrant young Laphroaig whose maturation has been speeded up by ageing in quarter casks. This shows soft sweetness and a velvety feel when first tasted, then the intense peatiness so unique to Laphroaig comes bursting through. 1oz-10.75 2oz-20.50

Bruichladdich

Scottish Barley Orange on the nose, with mild vanillins and lemon. The barley is still recognizable through it all. Taste of grassy Sauvignon Blanc tones. A very slight (but very nice) fuel note that dissipates with time in the glass and a touch of pepper. Quite drying. Finishes longer than average with honey and vanilla. 1oz-10.75 2oz-20.50

Octomore Famous for being made with the most heavily peated barley on the planet. Bruichladdich are still able to impart a delicate, graceful emphasis within this intense whisky. 1oz-24 2oz-44

Port Charlotte Master distiller Jim McEwan specially chose the casks that create the Port Charlotte Scottish Barley, which highlight the elegance within this heavily peated single malt. Made with 100% Scottish barley and matured in the village of Port Charlotte. 1oz-10.75 2oz-20.50

Islay Barley Made from barley harvested at Rockside Farm, Islay, in 2006 and distilled in 2007. The specially selected grain, the slow distillation and carefully considered casks were vital in creating this iconic unpeated single malt. 1oz-10.75 2oz-20.50

Bunnahabhain (12)

Double Matured in Ex Bourbon and Ex Sherry Casks, this whisky is beautifully rich and full-bodied, achieving the perfect balance of the characteristic nutty and sherry flavours of Bunnahabhain. Light with fruit notes, nutty flavours with a sweetness and slight hints of vanilla and caramel. 1oz-10.75 2oz-20.50



Speyside

Tomatin (18)

Sweet and honeyed at first, with an oaky edge. Develops in the mouth with a bite of citrus and a hint of dark chocolate. The finish is long and lingering, with warming alcohol and smooth rich sherry. 1oz-18 2oz-32

Cragganmore (12)

Currant bushes, sweet fruits, honey. The palate has a lovely weight: honey, blackberry, walnut, dried apricot. A tingle of heathery smoke bind it together on the finish. 1oz-10.75 2oz-20.50

Dalwhinnie (15)

A very aromatic nose. The palate is smooth and lasting with heather, honey sweetness and vanilla, all with a long, surprisingly intense finish that gives way to smoke, peat and malt. 1oz-14.50 2oz-27

The Macallan

12 Year Amber in color with a nose of sherry, honey, and flower. Full-bodied and smooth, the flavour hints of flowering currant, with a rounded finish. 1oz-13.75 2oz-26

18 Year A dried fruit and ginger nose gives way to a palate of rich dried fruits, with spice, clove, orange and wood smoke. Ends with a lingering finish, with dried fruits and sweet toffee. 1oz-44 2oz-79

Glenfarclas (12)

Citrus notes in the aroma, with a soft vanilla, malt and lightly nutty palate. Finish is soft and lightly fruity with a hint of chocolate. Very clean, well-made and attractive. 1oz-9 2oz-17.50

anCnoc (12)

Soft, very aromatic with a hint of honey and lemon in the foreground. Sweet to start with an appetising fruitiness and a long smooth finish. A malt for every occasion. 1oz-8.75 2oz-17

Speyburn (10)

Soft and malty on the nose, with a heather honey aroma. The palate is medium-bodied with a lovely balance struck between spice, dry nut and sweetness. Finishes spicy and slightly dry. 1oz-6.25 2oz-11

The Balvenie Portwood (21)

An additional period of maturation in 30 year-old port pipes has given this aged Balvenie an extra level of depth and concentration of flavour, adding potent fruit and smoke notes to the silky-smooth full-bodied palate. Rich, indulgent, after-dinner Speyside at its best. 1oz-33 2oz-62

Aberlour (12)

A fine example of how the distinctively crisp, citrus character of Aberlour's new distillate is deftly softened by double cask maturation. Traditional Oak and seasoned Sherry butts are both used to great effect, as the mellowed spirits within are combined to deliver a subtly balanced flavour. 1oz-10.75 2oz-20.50

The Glenlivet

12 Year Aromatic, with flowers and a subtly peaty palate. Sweet and fruity, with vanilla notes. Well-balanced. Finishes mild and warming. 1oz-8.50 2oz-16.50

18 Year Aroma of peat, floral notes, sherry, honey and fruit. The palate is floral. Sweet and rich with a full spice and smoke finish. 1oz-20 2oz-36

Signatory 1st Fill Sherry Cask Glenlivet 15 yr

Dark gold color with first toffee, then gun powder smoke, roasted chestnuts, leather and espresso coffee flavors. Keeps developing with flavors of cassis buds and port wine. Finishes with long fruity and malty flavors. 1oz-16 2oz-29

Glenfiddich

12 Year Some citric notes (lemon/orange peel). Soft palate with vanilla, malt, and light nuttiness. Finishes soft and lightly fruity with a hint of chocolate. 1oz-8.75 2oz-17

Gran Reserva 21 Year Experience an intense and vanilla sweet aroma, floral with hints of banana, followed by a soft, lively taste with lime, ginger and spice and a complex and exceptionally long ending. 1oz-30 2oz-56

Solera Vat 15 Year An intriguingly complex aroma. Sweet heather honey and vanilla fudge combined with rich dark fruits. Silky smooth, revealing layers of sherry oak, marzipan, cinnamon and ginger. Full-bodied and bursting with flavour. Finishes satisfyingly rich with lingering sweetness. 1oz-12.25 2oz-23.50

18 Year Matured in a mix of Oloroso sherry and bourbon casks. Loads of fruit on the nose, with zesty grapefruit and baked toffee apples. On the palate, candied fruits and Glenfiddich freshness balances richer notes of dried apricot, more cinnamon and toffee, ginger and dry Sherry. Finishes with peels and a touch of salted toffee. 1oz-19 2oz-34

Aultmore (12)

Very fresh and vibrant on the nose, with clean, refreshing notes of Cox's apple and pear, with a gentle creaminess and some aromatic floral notes. A touch richer on the palate than expected, but still soft and fruity, with some sweet pastry/custard-tart notes. Finishes very clean and measured, with the soft fruits gently receding. 1oz-11.50 2oz-22

Tamdhu (12)

Rich and enticing nose of iced cinnamon rolls, orange boiled sweets, fresh sweet oak with raisins and the faint hint of mint. The palate has a silky texture that coats the mouth with banana, berry jam, malt biscuit and classic sherry oak depth. Finishes pleasantly long and balanced with ground spice, dried fruit and soft Scottish tablet – finally unveiling the merest wisp of peat smoke. 1oz-11.50 2oz-22



Highlands

Glengoyne (10)

Nose of toffee and popcorn aromas. Clean taste, with green apples and grass with a hint of liquorice. Finishes sweet and malty. 1oz-8.25 2oz-16

Oban (14)

Rich sweetness and fruits on the nose, with sea-salt and peaty smokiness. A rich palate of late autumn fruits - dried figs and honey-sweet spices. Finishes long, smooth-sweet finish with oak-wood, dryness and a grain of salt. 1oz-16 2oz-29

The Dalmore

12 Year cherry and oak nose, with a creamy toffee palate and a delicate, malty spice buzz. Finishes long with silky toffee and a wave of sweet liquorice. 1oz-12.25 2oz-23.50

15 Year Fine structure of sweet vanilla with aromatic cloves, cinnamon and ginger. Seville oranges, lemons and limes. 1oz-20 2oz-36

Glenmorangie

Original Sweet and delightfully spicy palate at first, then becomes richer and oilier. Barley sugar sweetness and some creeping oak. Finishes with a malt wave. 1oz-8.25 2oz-16

Quinta Ruban Port Wood Finish Glenmorangie ships Portuguese barrels to serve as further maturation for The Original, imprinting the spirit with a chocolatey mint aroma and ruby glow. 1oz-10.75 2oz-20.50

La Santa Sherry Wood Finish Sherry casks that retain the warmth and nutty flavours of this fortified wine are imported to the Scottish Highlands where they are filled with Original single malt whisky. 1oz-8.75 2oz-17

Nectar D'Or Sauternes Cask Finish Infused with the signature honey, citrus and spice aroma of the Sauternes dessert wine that lingers in the wooden casks, the result is a whisky of exquisite sophistication and complexity. 1oz-11.50 2oz-22

Clynelish (14)

A delightfully complex spicy and perfumed nose, with some floral and malty hints. The palate is multi-layered too, with some slight citrus hints on a honey background with peat and delicious spices before a honey finish with a trace of brine. 1oz-13.75 2oz-26

Aberfeldy (12)

Fresh and floral, with lively tropical fruit, honey, and vanilla. Gentle on the palate, with a slight syrupy texture to its malty foundation. Youthful, orange marmalade finish with a hint of spice. A pleasant, easy-going whisky. 1oz-7.50 2oz-14.50

Old Pulteney (12)

Medium to high intensity nose, dry with a briny hint of sea air. Sweet, floral, citrus palate: lemon and lime plus dry banana skin. Smooth and faintly salty. 1oz-8.25 2oz-16

Highland Park

12 Year The nose is sweet, heathery, malty, hint of sherry. Exceptionally smooth palate, with a succulent, smoky dryness, heathery-honey sweetness and maltiness. Finishes heathery. 1oz-10 2oz-19

18 Year Warm, notably flowery nose. Remarkably smooth flavor. Lightly salty. Leafy, pine nuts. Finishes spicy, very dry and oaky. 1oz-22 2oz-40

Royal Lochnagar (12)

Complex nose with sherry, stewed fruit, malty vanilla notes and a trace of smoke. Salty and slightly sour palate, mouth-coating with a medium to long finish. A favorite of Queen Victoria. 1oz-12.25 2oz-23.50

Scapa The Orcadian (Skiren)

Called the honeyed tropical one because of its smooth, creamy sweetness with a hint of tropical fruit, citrus and coastal heather. It is exclusively matured in first-fill American Oak Casks, selected by Scapa artisans. 1oz-19 2oz-34

Glen Ord (Signatory 12yr.)

Distilled 1998, Bottled 2010; Hogshead Aged

Rare independent bottling of Glen Ord, Color of straw with aromas of dried fruits (pear and banana), wax, oil and a hint of coal smoke. On the palate (neat) it is perfectly balanced between the raw power, the sweetness from the alcohol and the spirit's waxiness. With water (highly suggested) notes of barbecued fruits, smoke and various jams as well as a little lemon. Finish: long and fresh. 119.2 proof (Cask Strength). 1oz-12.25 2oz-23.50

Lowlands

Auchentoshan

American Oak Bourbon vanilla nose and coconut with layers of citrus fruit. Tastes refreshingly smooth yet lively with vanilla cream, coconut and white peach. Finishes crisp with sugared grapefruit and a hint of spice. 1oz-7.50 2oz-14.50

Three Wood A fruity nose, with a balanced palate of dark, syrupy, fruity, maturation flavours and cedary, oily, marshmallow, characteristics from the spirit itself. Finishes gentle, long, and warming with lemon grass and spice. 1oz-12.25 2oz-23.50

Glenkinchie (12)

Noticeable vanilla, cut flowers and beneath these, a clean, toasty note. Palate begins sweet and soft, soon becoming flowery again. The flavour settles into a bundle of butter-icing, lemon cheesecake and freesias. Nice herbal, dry finish. 1oz-13.75 2oz-26



Ashley's Lost Scotch Collection

**Like all businesses, over the years
Scotch distilleries do close.**

The global recession of the early 80's was particularly devastating to the Scotch whiskey industry with many closures. Also, as beverage companies have merged and gotten bigger they have closed older facilities with greater operating expenses regardless of the quality of the product. Lowland Scotches in particular fell out of favor with blenders and most were closed in the early 80's. This was before the current growth in single malts and few had distillery bottlings. It is rare to find any of these Scotches today and even rarer still to find a distillery bottling. With every cask of Rosebank or Banff that gets bottled, potential new bottlings from silent distilleries become rarer - and therefore more expensive. Ashley's has scoured sources all over the State to find these lost bottles of Scotch.

When they are gone they are gone.

Caperdonich (Signatory) 18yr.

Speyside, Distilled 1994, bottled 2012, 16%. Matured in a Hogshead Cask. Non-chill filtered, no color added.

Caperdonich distillery started its life in 1898 under the (relatively uninspiring) name 'Glen Grant #2'. Caperdonich distillery was founded by J. & J. Grant, the people that also built the 'original' Glen Grant distillery in 1840. Glen Grant Number Two remained inactive for six decades, but in the year 1965 it was rebuilt by Glenlivet Distilleries Ltd. who resumed production. The new owners also changed the name to Caperdonich ("Secret Well"). In 1977 Seagram from Canada acquired Caperdonich distillery - before selling it on to Pernod Ricard in 2001. Pernod Ricard closed the distillery one year later in 2002.

Fragrant nose, of cut damp grass/ hay, lemon, tropical fruit, malt. Taste is very sweet and creamy. Vanilla custard, canned mixed fruit, sugary syrup. Finishes sweet and spicy. chili, paprika, orange zest. 1oz-34 2oz-64

Littlemill (Hart Brothers) 20yr.

Lowland, Distilled 1984, bottled 2004. Matured in Oakwood Casks. Non-chill filtered, no color added

Littlemill distillery was a Scottish malt whisky distillery in Bowling, West Dunbartonshire. Situated on the border of Lowlands and Highlands, its products were generally classified as lowlands whisky. The distillery finally closed in 1994 after changing ownership several times, and was destroyed in a fire in 2004.

Opens with saccharine sweetness that carries through all the way to the back, quickly joined by grass clippings and a touch of citrus oil, with some bourbon cask notes hiding in the background. 1oz-25 2oz-46

Rare Ayrshire (Signatory) 37yr.

Lowlands, 48.5%. Matured in A Bourbon Barrel. Non-chill filtered, no color added.

Ayrshire is the code name used by several NDPs for the Ladyburn distillery that was closed in 1975 by William Grant & Sons. WG&S does continue to put out rare releases of this wonderful old whisky (some bottles priced at \$2000), but won't allow anyone but themselves to actually use the name Ladyburn.

The nose starts with some funky, woody and fruity notes which develop into grassy malt, toasted nuts and a charred sweetness like burned marshmallows and some earthy undertones. A nice layer of honeyed sweetness moves through the palate, along with some wood and a nutty overtone. In the background are some darker earthier notes. The finish fades out wood and fruit heavy at a medium pace with some trailing notes of nuts and cumin. 1oz-52 2oz-91

Imperial (Duncan Taylor) 17yr.

Speyside, Distilled 1995, bottled 2012, 53.2%. Matured in Oak Casks. Non-chill filtered, no color added.

Imperial was dogged by poor timing. Its chequered history meant that it never had a chance to become established as a single malt brand. Too late for the very earliest wave, by the time the category was becoming popular in the 1970s it was already committed to supplying fillings. When the single malt market came of age in the early 1990s, Imperial was closed.

Nose of olive, burnt orange zest, oak, and vanilla notes. A creamy palate with fruit and toasted grain. Finishes creamy and bright with touches of ginger and baking spice. 1oz-38 2oz-70

The Middleton-Very Rare From the County of Cork 2017 Edition

Ireland's most exclusive, and rare, whiskey. It is made from a blend of whiskies between 12 and 25 years old, from just a handful of carefully selected bourbon casks. Each bottle is numbered, and there is a distinct difference from one year's blend to the next. Middleton has elements of pot-still Irish Whisky, but is accented toward a sweetish maltiness. It is remarkably smooth and medium bodied with hints of Bourbon. 40.00

The Tryconnell From the County of Westmeath

Full and fruity aroma with a citrus – spiciness taste, which is well structured with honey notes hanging from the nose. A tang of oranges and lemons, a strong malt presence that balances well with the oily sweetness. Finishes long with the malt becoming more dominant to the end without the soft fruits and honey, which helped make up the middle. 8.00

Bushmill's

Single Malt 10 year Triple distilled from 100% malted barley and matured for a minimum of 10 years mainly in bourbon-seasoned barrels, it has aromas of honey, vanilla, and milk chocolate with a crisp, clean, and gently drying finish. 9.00

Clontarf Classic

Velvety soft nose with cream toffee and a lush, full textured taste, fat and toffee-sweet. The finish lingers, with subtle vanilla bolstered by the late arrival of intriguing spice. 6.50

Teeling Single Grain

Irish single grain whiskey from Teeling! There are only an elite few Irish single grain whiskies out there at the moment, but Teeling went ahead and made theirs unique by maturing it in Californian Cabernet Sauvignon casks. Deliciously sweet with a good deal of spice and fruit. 9.00

Red Label A rich, full-bodied blend of up to 35 aged single malt and grain whiskies. It's vibrancy makes it perfect for mixing. 6.75
